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Description of Training

Basic Training: A comprehensive training that provides participants with an overview of the how the system of behavioral health is structured, funded and operationalized. Participants will gain an understanding of the 12 principles, how families get started within the behavioral health system and an in-depth explanation of support and services available to eligible youth and families.

Billing and Documentation Training: This training will provide an explanation of the funding sources that allow SWN and provider agencies to deliver services to our families. This training will introduce staff to the elements of strong documentation through detailed examples and attendees will also be introduced to the billing codes and participate in several hands-on and group practice opportunities.

Building Bridges between Community and Out of Home Care: To understand how out of home interventions can be prevented as well as strategically used. To understand the process of requesting an out of home intervention as well as how to effectively transition a child out of that setting and back in to the community. **Trainer: Amber Robertson**

Creating Partnerships with CPS: This training will provide a basic overview of Child Protective Services and how it relates to the behavioral health system. The training will also provide an overview of how behavioral health staff can collaborate with Child Protective Services to create successful partnerships. **Trainer: Kelli MacKay**

DSM Overview: This training is designed to introduce the individual to the Diagnostic Statistical Manual – IV – Text Revision. The training will provide an introduction to the multi-axial assessment scale and will introduce the individual to commonly used DSM-IV diagnoses in the Maricopa County area. **Trainer: Dr. David Sanchez**

Facilitation 101—High Needs: A comprehensive training on the Child and Family Tea practice model intended for facilitators working with youth and families with intensive needs. Required for all SWN facilitators prior to their first CFT. **Trainer: Cindy Grsevinsky**

Facilitation 101— Targeted/Universal: A comprehensive training on the Child and Family Tea practice model intended for facilitators working with youth and families identified as having targeted and universal needs. **Trainer: Cindy Grsevinsky**

Finding and Connecting with Family Members (Finding Fa/Conn): In this training we will discuss and understand the value and benefits of family and community involvement for the individuals we serve. We will also review the necessary skills involved when setting out to locate and engage family and community members. And finally this training offers activities to practice the skills we have learned, a list of resources on how to find family connections, and data which validates why community and family connections are necessary supports for individuals to achieve certain goals. **Trainer: Cindy Grsevinsky**

Description of Training

HMS Training: Learn how to use the electronic keeping system that SWN uses to document activities outlined in the Billing and Documentation training. **Trainer: Anora Carriveau**

Legal Issues in Case Management: The training will go over the different types of juvenile court involvement (dependency and delinquency), types of probation, roles of the probation officer, tips for attending court, and how to work with the different parties involved. **Trainer: Alicia Magera**

Natural and Peer Support: This training will introduce staff to the roles of the Parent Partner and the Family Support Partner. Staff will have a deeper understanding of the role of parents as Peer to Peer Supporters and as Interventionists/Planners and be trained on the referral process. Also in this training we will share the importance of informal, natural and community base supports and services. **Trainer: Kim Foy**

SMI Workshop: This is a 2-part Series. If you have questions about completing the SMI Packet, this workshop will walk you through the process for submitting an SMI Packet: Part 1 is learning the paperwork and timelines. Part 2 covers completing the Core Assessment and Addendum. **Trainer: Steve Ballan**

Support Plan Refresher: This training revisits the entire Support Planning process and concludes with the creation of an actual Support Plan. This is a REFRESHER course, open exclusively to those staff who have previously attended either FAC 101 – Intensive, or FAC 101 – Targeted and Universal. **Trainer: Cindy Grsevinsky**

Transition to Adulthood: This training will take a holistic approach to assisting teens, young adults, and families plan for the transition to adulthood. This includes planning for the transition domains of living situation, education, employment, and community life. A comprehensive look at how to prepare young adults for a successful adulthood will be discussed; tools and resources will be given to serve as guides. **Trainer: Steve Ballan**
