

The 2nd Annual Southwest Network ART CONTEST 2010

ENTRY GUIDELINES

ELIGIBILITY & DIVISIONS

Eligibility: Open to all recipients and staff of Southwest Network. (That's all recipients, Titled or non-Titled. However the contest is not open to family members or other providers.)

Divisions: Adult (over 18 years), High School (14–18 years) and Youth (up to 13 years).

ENTRY GUIDELINES

Entry Fee: None.

Entry Limit:
Three (3) per person.
(A series counts as one entry.)

Deadline: September 17

Where to Deliver Entries:
Any Southwest Network clinic/
office or our administrative headquar-
ters, 2700 N. Central Ave., Suite 1050,
Phoenix. (Please package your artwork so it
doesn't get damaged when we move it around.)

Artwork: All artwork should be current (within the
last three years) and ready to hang or display.

Labeling: An entry form must be securely taped
to the back in the upper right corner, or securely
attached to the back in some way. Please do this
prior to delivering your entry.

Artwork not accepted: Videos/film, clothing, furniture, sexually ex-
plicit work, entries over 60" in height or width, or entries more than
30 pounds in weight cannot be accepted. Work that won an award in
the Southwest Network Art Contest 2009 also will not be accepted.

SELECTION AND AWARDS

One Best of Show winner chosen from all divisions will receive \$200 and the artwork will become a *permanent* part of Southwest Network's exhibit at their administrative headquarters. First place winners in each division (Adult, High School, Youth) will each receive \$25. Second and Third place awards in each category may be given, and those winners will each receive two movie passes. Categories with limited entries may be combined with another category for award purposes. All award winners will be notified and will receive their prizes no later than November 30, 2010.

EXHIBITION

ALL entries will be shown on our Web site at www.SouthwestNetwork.org/art.htm. By entering the contest you are giving us permission to publish your artwork online. Your name will be displayed, but no other personal information will be published. If you do not want your name displayed, please check the "NO" box on the entry form.

ONLY entries receiving an award will be put on exhibit at our headquarters for one year and therefore will not be returned to the artists until October 2011.

Entries *not* receiving an award will be returned to the artists in November 2010. Be sure to fill out the entry form completely so we can return your artwork to you.

SELLING YOUR ARTWORK

Entries do not have to be for sale, but if you would like us to give your name to interested parties so they can contact you about purchasing your artwork, please check the "YES" box on the entry form.

LIABILITY

While every precaution will be taken to avoid damage to the entries, Southwest Network assumes no responsibility in the event of loss or damage. Southwest Network does not carry insurance on artwork entered in the contest. If insurance is desired, it is the responsibility of the artist to secure it.

DATES TO REMEMBER

- September 17:** Deadline to enter and deliver artwork to a Southwest Network clinic/office
- November 2010:** Winners will be announced and will receive their prizes
- November 2010:** Artwork will be returned to those who did not receive an award
- December 2010:** Exhibitions of winning artwork on Web site and at administrative headquarters begin
- September 2011:** Exhibitions close
- October 2011:** Artwork returned to winning/exhibiting artists

3. Tape the form to the upper right corner of each entry (or, attach it securely if it can't be taped).
4. Package your artwork carefully so it doesn't get damaged when we move it around.
5. Deliver your entry (or entries) to any Southwest Network clinic/office or to our administrative headquarters at 2700 N. Central Ave., Suite 1050, Phoenix on or before September 17.
